Payne*, 111 F.4th 902 (8th Cir. 2024), which resulted in the successful vacating of an adverse summary judgment order via unanimous panel opinion. Derek also participated in numerous moot court competitions including the annual Wiley Rutledge Moot Court Competition, in which he advanced to the semi-final round and earned both an Outstanding Speaker and Outstanding Brief award, and the Judge John R. Brown Admiralty Moot Court Competition, where his team's brief received third place.
