She has played a key role in multiple trial teams. Most recently, Holly was part of the trial team in *United States v. Jitesh Thakkar*, the first-ever criminal case charging a non-trader with a form of market manipulation. Holly and the team secured a judgment of acquittal on a conspiracy count in the case, and 10 out of 12 jurors voted for acquittal on the remaining counts. The Justice Department dismissed the remaining counts shortly thereafter.
